## Cabinet Resolution No. (12) of 2021

# Concerning the Fees of Services Provided by the Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure

#### The Cabinet:

- Having reviewed the Constitution; and
- Federal Law No. (1) of 1972, On the Jurisdictions of Ministries and the Powers of Ministers, as amended; and
- Federal Law No. (26) of 1981. On the Maritime Commercial Law, as amended; and
- Federal Law No. (9) of 2011, On the Land Transport, as amended; and
- Federal Law No. (14) of 2016, On the Administrative Violations and Sanctions in the Federal Government; and
- Federal Law No (14) of 2017, On Petroleum Products Trading; and
- Federal Decree-Law No. (26) of 2019, On Public Finance; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (27) of 2005, Concerning the Fees for Services Provided by Department for Maritime Transport Affairs at the Ministry of Transport; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (17) of 2010, Concerning Regulating the Use of Federal Roads and Facilities; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (28) of 2012, Concerning the Federal Fees and Fines for Services of the State Land Transport; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (7) of 2013, Concerning the Fees of Selling Geological Reports, Publications and Maps; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (4) of 2015, Concerning the Fees for Services Provided by Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure, as amended; and
- Based upon the proposal submitted by the Minister of Finance and the Cabinet's approval, Has resolved:

### Article (1)

#### Definitions

In application of the provisions of this Resolution, the following words shall have the meanings assigned thereto, unless the context requires otherwise:

#### Article (2)

#### **Fees of Services**

- In consideration of the services provided by the Ministry that are shown in tables (1), (2), (3), (6) and (7) attached to this Resolution, the fees assigned thereto shall be collected.
- 2. A fee for ownership transfer of a national commercial vessel that is (6.5) Dirhams per (ton) of the gross tonnage of the vessel shall be collected, provided that the maximum fee shall not exceed (ten thousand Dirhams) and the minimum fee shall not be less than (200) Dirhams.
- 3. A fee for issuing a license for a pleasure ship owned by a foreigner that is (6.5) Dirhams per (ton) of the gross tonnage of the ship shall be collected. Besides, the renewal of this licenses shall for a fee that is (3) Dirhams per (ton) of the gross tonnage of the ship, provided that the fee shall not be less than (500) Dirhams.
- 4. Upon the issuance of each navigation licence for foreign vessels working in the regional waters of the State, a fee of (7) Dirhams per ton of the total recorded tonnage of the vessel shall be collected. Upon extending this license for a period that does not exceed a year, a fee of (5) Dirhams per ton of the total recorded tonnage of the vessel shall be collected. This is provided that the maximum fee is (150.000) Dirhams and minimum fee shall not be less than (500) Dirhams.
- 5. The Ministry shall collect fees for the international land transit that are (100) Dirhams in addition to (10) Dirhams per ton for each land transport movement that occurs upon the entrance of all national and foreign vehicles dedicated for transporting goods at the land ports of the State.
- 6. The Ministry shall collect fees for the international land transit that are (100) Dirhams in addition to (20) Dirhams per ton for each land transport movement that occurs upon the

entrance of all national and foreign vehicles dedicated for transporting passengers at the land ports of the State.

7. Fees of services stipulated in clauses from (204) to (268) shall not include the cost of packing, shipping or customs.

# Article (3)

### Administrative Penalties and Violations

- 1. The Ministry shall collect the administrative fines stipulated in table (4) attached to this Resolution.
- 2. The Ministry shall collect the administrative fines stipulated in table (5) attached to this Resolution for road obstructions and damages resulting from accidents and speed on federal roads.
- 3. The Ministry shall collect the following administrative fines:
  - a. An administrative fine of (100) one hundred Dirhams shall be imposed on soil research providers shall for each year where the renewal of registration at the register is delayed.
  - b. An administrative fine of (500) five hundred Dirhams shall be imposed on consultants, contractors and suppliers of construction works for each year where the renewal of registration at the register is delayed.
  - c. The fines aforementioned in Paragraphs (A) and (B) of this Article shall be collected, in addition to the fees to renew the registration as shown in the table attached to this Resolution, not exceeding three years. In case renewal of registration is delayed for more than such period, registration shall be cancelled.
  - d. For the purposes of calculating the fines stipulated in Paragraphs (A) and (B) of this Article, a part of a year shall be deemed a full year.
  - e. An administrative fine shall be imposed if a pleasure ship license (for a citizen or a foreigner) is not renewed within (60) sixty days as of the expiry date, with (50) Dirhams per month or part of month, provided that the maximum fine shall be (200) Dirhams.

- f. An administrative fine shall be imposed if a navigation license for a national commercial vessel is not renewed within (60) sixty days as of the expiry date, with (100) Dirhams per month or part of month, provided that the maximum fine shall be (1000) Dirhams.
- g. An administrative fine shall be imposed if the minimum manning certificate for a national commercial vessel is not renewed within (60) sixty days as of the expiry date, with (50) Dirhams per month or part of month, provided that the maximum fine shall be (300) Dirhams.
- An administrative fine shall be imposed if a navigation license for a national commercial vessel is not renewed within (60) sixty days as of the expiry date, with (50) Dirhams per month or part of month, provided that the maximum fine shall be (200) Dirhams.
- 4. Every relevant person may grieve in writing to the Ministry against any of the aforementioned administrative fines in this Resolution that is imposed on that person within (15) fifteen days from the date of notification of the grieved decision, provided that the grievance shall be justified, and all supporting documents are attached. Grievance shall be decided within (30) thirty days from the date of submission pursuant to procedures applicable in the Ministry.

### Article (4)

#### Amendments of Fees and Fines

Cabinet shall be the competent authority to make any amendment on the administrative fees and fines stipulated in this Resolution, whether through addition, deletion or amendment.

# Article (5)

### **Collection of Fees and Fines**

Fees and fines stipulated in this Resolution shall be collected through the methods decided by the Ministry of Finance.

#### Article (6)

#### **Bank Guarantee**

Insurer, Automobile and touring clubs shall provide a bank guarantee of one million Dirhams in the name of the Ministry issued by one of the banks working in the State upon issuing a license to practice the activity of CPD for private vehicles, IDL, and permits for trucks and passengers buses to pass. Validity of the bank guarantee shall be unlimited, and it shall not be retrieved to the owner of the license unless after (90) days as of the cancellation date of the license.

### Article (7)

# Costs of Designing and Execution of Entrances of Private Investment Projects

The Ministry shall collect the costs of designing and execution of any permanent entrances of private investment projects on federal roads from the owners of those projects in addition to administrative, supervisory and maintenance expenses of (10%) of the cost value. Coordination shall be made between the Ministry and the Ministry of Finance to determine the method of collecting such costs from the entities owning such projects and the method to pay the dues of the entities performing designing and execution works.

#### Article (8)

#### Organising the Use of Federal Roads and Facilities

The Ministry shall have the sole right to use federal roads and facilities pursuant to provisions stipulated in this Resolution. The Ministry also shall be entitled to designate road reserve according to the requirements issued by the Minister in this respect.

### Article (9)

- 1. Without prejudice to any other federal entity, the Ministry shall be competent to do the following:
  - a. Estimating and violations arising due to traffic accidents and speed on federal roads and the cost of repair.

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- b. Determining the costs of removing and remedies the violations and obstructions violators do not remove or remedy upon discretion of the Ministry.
- c. Performing necessary repairs to remedy the impacts of traffic accidents and amendments.
- d. Removing the committed violations if the same are not removed within the period designated by the Ministry.
- 2. The Ministry shall inform the ones who violate the provisions of this resolution to pay the cost of the above-mentioned repair and removal works in addition to 15% as administrative and supervisory expenses and these shall be sent to the public treasury of the State.
- 3. The Minister or his delegate shall consider the grievance petitions submitted to the Ministry with respect to the stipulation of Paragraph (1) of this Article, provided that the suitable way to accept such grievances shall be determined within a month as of the notification date sent to the violators to pay the cost of repair and removal. Decisions of the Minister or his delegate shall be final for the grievances submitted in this respect.

#### Article (10)

Agencies that are authorised to work at the reserve of the federal roads and facilities shall provide financial guarantees determined by the Ministry as a guarantee for the commitment of such agencies to take care of technical and legal specifications of roads and to repair any damages that may occur to the road or its accessories. This shall be done by either of the following:

- a. Providing guarantees in the form of amounts of money to be deposited in cash at bank accounts determined by the Ministry of Finance for this purpose.
- b. Providing letters of credit issued by one of the banks working in the State, provided that such letters shall be unconditional, irrevocable and with the same amounts. This shall be pursuant to the requirements determined by the Ministry in coordination with the Ministry of Finance.

#### Article (11)

- The Ministry shall be entitled to collect fees for publishing advertisements and media on federal roads and facilities, provided that such fees shall be in coordination with the Ministry of Finance and subject to requirements and executive regulation of this Resolution. A Cabinet resolution shall be issued to determine these fees based on the proposal of the Minister of Finance.
- 2. The Ministry shall be entitled to make contracts with specialized companies and corporations to grant them the right to use the federal roads and facilities through advertisements and media subject to the law of tenders or bids applicable in the Federal Government.

#### Article (12)

The Ministry shall be entitled to collect fees for the use of federal roads and facilities after coordination with the Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Interior. The Cabinet shall issue a resolution for such fees and schedules of collection based on the proposal of the Minister of Finance.

#### Article (13)

The Ministry may determine the speeds allowed on the federal roads and places of Radar installations in coordination with the Ministry of Interior, provided that all revenues of Radars fixed on federal roads shall go to the public treasury of the State.

### Article (14)

#### **Final Provisions**

The Ministry's employees designated by a decision of the Minister of Justice in agreement with the Minister shall have the capacity of judicial officers for seizing and establishing violations subject to the provisions of this Resolution and the regulations and requirements issued in implementation hereof within their jurisdiction.

## Article (15)

#### **Executive Resolutions**

- 1. The Minister shall issue the Resolutions necessary to apply the provisions of this Resolution.
- 2. The Minister shall designate the federal roads and facilities on which this Resolution shall be applicable.

## Article (16)

#### Repeals

- 1. The following resolutions shall be repealed:
  - a. Cabinet Resolution No. (27) of 2005 Concerning the Fees for Services Provided by Department for Maritime Transport Affairs at the Ministry of Transport.
  - b. Cabinet Resolution No. (17) of 2010 on Regulating the Use of Federal Roads and Facilities.
  - c. Cabinet Resolution No. (28) of 2012 Regarding the Federal Fees and Fines for Services of the State Land Transport.
  - d. Cabinet Resolution No. (7) of 2013 Regarding the Fees of Selling Geographical and Geophysical Reports, Publications and Maps.
  - e. Cabinet Resolution No. (4) of 2015 Concerning the Fees for Services Provided by Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure, as amended.
  - f. Minister of Finance Resolution No. (268) of 2006.
  - g. Minister of Finance Resolution No. (108) of 2007.
- 2. Any provision that violates or contradicts this Resolution shall be repealed.

# Article (17)

### **Publication and Enforcement**

This Resolution shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall be enforced as of the day following the date of its publication.
