

Cabinet Resolution No. (3) of 2020 Regarding Mandatory Standards Related to the Electricity Sector in the United Arab Emirates

The Cabinet:

- Having reviewed the Constitution; and
- Federal Law No. (1) of 1972, concerning the competences of ministries and the capacities of ministers and its amendments thereof; and
- Federal Law No. (28) of 2001, establishing the Emirates Standards and Metrology Authority and its amendments thereof; and
- Cabinet Resolution No. (17) of 2016, concerning the application of mandatory standards in the United Arab Emirates; and
- Based upon the Cabinet's approval,

Hereby decides:

Article (1)

The standards related to the electricity sector, whose numbers and titles are shown in the below attached schedule, are considered standards of mandatory application in the United Arab Emirates.

Article (2)

All concerned authorities, present at the time of application of this resolution, shall adjust its status in compliance with its provisions within (180) days from its date of enforcement.

Article (3)

This resolution shall be published in the official gazette, and shall come into force as of the day following its date of publication.
